**DISTRICT MEETING:** The next District V meeting is scheduled for December 19, 2000, 7:30pm at the Wesco Youth Soccer Office at 130 South Main Street, Suite 213, Sebastopol. On the corner of South Main Street and Burnett Ave (upstairs).

**ASSOCIATION CUP:** The Class III and IV, U16's and U19's will have semi-open Cup at the state level. Any U16 or U19 team that wishes to enter A-Cup may still be sent by sending the entry form to the CYSA office before January 5, 2001. Entry forms that arrive after January 5, 2001, will not be accepted.

**CLASS I:** Coordinators may contact Marja at (707-762-8368). The Trophy Company will call the coach and make arrangement to either ship them to the coach or have the coach pick them up.

**CLASS III:** The Trophy Company will call the coach and make arrangement to either ship the trophies to the coach or have the coach pick them up. Kathy Dunnagan has contacted the coaches that will be attending Chevy Association Cup in January.

**COACHING:** Remember coaching course can be given any time of the year. Leagues can set up your coaches clinics now, by have your league-coaching director set the desired date, alternate date, a check for \$400.00 made payable to CYSA and mail the request to Henry Bills at 1161 San Antonio Drive, Rohnert Park, CA 94928.

**DISTRICT CUP:** District Cup was held November 18th and 19th. A great weekend was had by all at all sites. NO RAIN this year at any site. The first three places in each age group will be attending Chevy Association Cup the weekend of January 6th and 7th in different site in northern California. Congratulation to all teams, coaches and the parents of these teams.

**JAMBOREES: PLEASE REMEMBER TO REMIND YOUR COACHES THAT THEY MUST HAVE THEIR LEAGUE'S AND THE DISTRICT'S APPROVE TO HOST OR ATTEND A JAMBOREE. JAMBOREES MAY NOT BE HOSTED ON A CYSA TOURNAMENT WEEKEND IN DISTRICT V IN WHICH THE HOME LEAGUE IS HOSTING A TOURNAMENT.** Remember to give the coaches the request to host a jamboree.

**OUT OF STATE SINGLE EVENT GUEST PLAYER** forms must be to me 5 days before the date the team leaves. Coaches may not take more than (18) eighteen players on their travel roster at any time. Teams may use up to six guest players providing the out of state tournament allows that many guest players. Players from other districts may be used as guest players with the permission of the coaches, leagues and District Commissioners. **DO NOT ASK FOR GUEST PLAYER OUT OF DISTRICT VII.**

**OUT OF STATE TRAVEL: PLEASE INFORM YOUR COACHES OF THIS POLICY.** When traveling out of state, this includes Southern California; the team must have travel papers signed by the league, CYSA office and me.

**ALL PLAYERS ARE REQUIRED TO SIGN THE BLUE TRAVEL ROSTER IN DISTRICT V. PAPERS WILL BE RETURNED IF THEY ARE NOT COMPLETED CORRECTLY.** Travel papers must be submitted to me 45 days in advance of your travel date. **PLEASE SEND A COPY OF THE TEAM ROSTER INCLUDING ALL ADDS, RELEASES, AND TRANSFERS.** Please remember to enclose the necessary envelopes, correctly addressed and postage with a check made out to CYSA for \$10.00. Follow the instructions on the back of the form.

**REFEREES:** If your league would like to set up a class please send Dave the two different dates that you would like to have a class along with a check for \$270.00 made out to CNRA for each class you would like. If you do not send dates, the time and the place for the class you will not receive the class until you do. Referee courses will be listed on the District V web site when the webmaster receives them.

**REGISTRATION: REMEMBER THAT LACK OF PREPLANNING ON YOUR PART DOES NOT CONSTITUTE AN EMERGENCY ON THE DISTRICT REGISTRAR'S PART.**

**RULE CHANGES:** The changes that were received will be typed and distributed to the leagues after the beginning of the new year and the district will vote on them at March or April meeting.

**SENDOFFS AND RED CARDS:** There are far too many sent-offs and red cards this season. The behavior of coaches is unacceptable. We have had six coaches sent off the field of play for presently questioning the referees calls and having a running commentary on the sidelines. I am sure that there were many more times that coaches could have or should have been sent from the field of play, if the referee had done so. **REMEMBER IT IS THE COACH THAT SETS THE TONE ON THE GAME. IF THE COACH IS UNDER CONTROL, AND EXPECTS THE PARENTS ON THE TEAM TO CONTROL THEMSELVES WE WOULD NOT HAVE THE NUMBER OF SENDOFFS THAT WE ARE GETTING.** Players also would control themselves on the field if the coaches control themselves on the sidelines.
