DISTRICT MEETING: The next District V meeting is scheduled for September 18, 2001, 7:30 pm at the Novato San Marin High School Library in Novato, CA. Direction off 101 hwy. Take the San Marin exit, go west approximately 5 miles to South Novato Blvd. The school is on the right turn into the parking lot. The meeting room is in the Library Building C.

COACHING: Remember coaching course can be given anytime of the year. Leagues can set up your coaches clinics now, by have your league-coaching director set the desired date, alternate date, a check for \$400.00 made payable to CYSA and mail there quest to Jan Bull at 5250 Wendell Lane Sebastopol, CA 95473. **I am looking for a new coaching coordinator for District V. If you are interested in this position or know of someone who would be interested in this position please call me.**

FEE INCREASE: USSF has increased the fee that the state organization must pay per player by fifty cents. This fee increase is in effect for this coming season. CYSA at the present time is trying to figure out how to pay the fee for the coming season without going back to the membership and asking for it retroactively. At the February Annual General Meeting CYSA will be most likely be asking for a fee increase of at least fifty cents maybe a \$1.00 as it is anticipated that USYS will also be asking for a fee increase.

GUEST PLAYER SINGLE EVENTS FORMS: Please remind all your coaches CYSA tournament single event forms for in state tournament are to be sent to Steve Pinner for approval, at least 10 days before the tournament. Class I players may not be used as a guest player for Class III or Class IV teams. If Class III or IV players are used as guest players for a Class I team that player is disqualify form playing in Chevy Association or Tide Cup. Class III players may not guest on a Class IV team, if a Class IV player guest on a Class III team that player is disqualify from Tide Cup.

JAMBOREES: PLEASE REMEMBER TO REMIND YOUR COACHES THAT THEY MUST HAVE THEIR LEAGUES AND THE DISTRICTS APPROVE TO HOST OR ATTEND A JAMBOREE. JAMBOREES MAY NOT BE HOSTED ON A CYSA TOURNAMENT WEEKEND IN DISTRICT V IN WHICH THE HOME LEAGUE IS HOSTING A TOURNAMENT. Remember to give the coaches the request to host a jamboree. All jamboree requests go to Ken Stelling at 6 Barona Court, Santa Rosa, CA 95405. District V jamborees are listed on the District V website<cysadistrictv.com>

OPEN BOUNDARIES: Open boundaries for league-to-league was approved for U16's and older, all other players are still required to have an Inter-League release. All players moving from district to district MUST still have an Inter-District Release form completed by both leagues and District Commissioners.

OUT OF STATE SINGLE EVENT GUEST PLAYER forms must be to me 7 days before the date the team leaves. Coaches may not take more than (18) eighteen players on their travel roster at any time. Teams may use up to six guest players providing the out of state tournament allows that many guest players. Guest players must use the same years player pass as the team that they will be traveling with. Players from other districts may be used as guest players with the permission of the coaches, leagues and District Commissioners. **DO NOT ASK FOR GUEST PLAYER OUT OF DISTRICT VII. Class I players may not be used as a guest player for Class III or Class IV teams. If Class III or IV players are used as guest players for a Class I team that player is disqualify from playing in Chevy Association or Tide Cup. Class III players may not guest on a Class IV team, if a Class IV player guest on a Class III team that player is disqualify from Tide Cup.**

OUT OF STATE TRAVEL: PLEASE INFORM YOUR COACHES OF THIS POLICY. When traveling out of state, this includes Southern California; the team must have travel papers signed by the league, Ken Stelling, CYSA office and me. ALL PLAYERS ARE REQUIRED TO SIGN THE BLUE TRAVEL ROSTER IN DISTRICT V. PAPERS WILL BE RETURNED IF THEY ARE NOT COMPLETED CORRECTLY. Travel papers must be submitted to 50 days in advance of your travel date. PLEASE SEND A COPY OF THE TEAM ROSTER INCLUDING ALL ADDS, RELEASES, AND TRANSFERS AND THE TOURNAMENTS APPROVAL FROM USYSA TO HOST AN OUT OF STATE TOURNAMENT. Please remember to enclose the necessary envelopes, correctly addressed and postage with a check made out to CYSA for \$10.00. All requests to travel out of state for tournament must go to Ken Stelling before they come to me. Follow the instructions on the back of the form.

REGISTRATION: Remember that 75% of your league registration was due to Steve by September 1, 2000, with the correct fees. (PIM 99-1 of the CYSA Team Manual) Rosters are due ASAP. Your teams must turn into the CYSA office a copy of their roster when they apply for Chevy or Tide Cup. **REMEMBER THAT LACK OF PREPLANNING ON YOUR PART DOES NOT CONSTITUTE AN EMERGENCY ON THE DISTRICT REGISTRARS PART.**

RED CARDS, SEND-OFFS OR EJECTIONS: Please remind your league referees that the send-off / ejection reports from the District V Playing League are to be sent to Mike Mullins P.O. Box 184, Kenwood, CA 95452, within 24 hours.

SEND-OFFS AND RED CARDS: REMEMBER IT IS THE COACH THAT SETS THE TONE ON THE GAME. IF THE COACH IS UNDER CONTROL, AND EXPECTS THE PARENTS ON THE TEAM TO CONTROL THEMSELVES players also would control themselves on the field and on the sidelines.
