DISTRICT MEETING: There will be no district meeting this month, as I will be in Mexico for a little R & R. Please contact the appropriate coordinator if you have any questions. Steve Pinner will be taking care of all travel papers and guest player forms.

ASSOCIATION CUP: A-Cup started this weekend at many different sites. Next weekend will be the round of 16 and the semis and the finals will be held the weekend of March 23rd and 24th.

CLASS I: contact Marja (707-762-8368) mktarr@attbi.com. Marja will be setting the Class I meeting in the beginning of June. Remember this is a mandatory meeting for ALL Class I coaches. If you coach or team representative is not there it could mean that they will not be playing this season. As usually the younger Class I teams will play in the fall and the older teams will play starting in late November or early December. There will be go-arounds for these age group.

CLASS III: please contact Patricia at 707-252-4570 or bluem00n55@aol.com. Patricia will be setting up a date for the Class III meeting in the latter part of April or the first part of May. Please start checking with you clubs to see how many teams will be entering.

COACHING: Leagues can set up your coaches clinics now, by have your league-coaching director set the desired date, alternate date, the "F" course is \$500.00 please made the check payable to CYSA and mail the request to Ray Erlach 27 Carnoustie Drive, Novato, CA 94949 (415-788-3322).

FEE INCREASE: At the CYSA Annual General Meeting a fee increase was approved. The fee due to CYSA this year will be **\$11.50 per player**, that is an increase from the \$9.75 that was paid last year.

GOAL POST: I WANT TO TAKE THIS TIME TO REMIND ALL LEAGUES THAT GOAL POST ARE TO BE ANCHORED DOWN SECURELY, PLEASE TAKE THIS TIME TO MAKE SURE THIS IS DONE. CYSA IS FACING A \$1,000,000,000 CLAIM BASED ON THE ALLEGATIONS THAT A 9-YEAR OLD WAS INJURED WHEN A SOCCER GOAL THAT WAS NOT ANCHORED FELL ON HER. LET'S MAKE SURE IT DOES NOT HAPPEN IN DISTRICT V.

JAMBOREES: PLEASE REMEMBER TO REMIND YOUR COACHES THAT THEY MUST HAVE THEIR LEAGUES AND THE DISTRICTS APPROVE TO HOST OR ATTEND A JAMBOREE. JAMBOREES MAY NOT BE HOSTED ON A CYSA TOURNAMENT WEEKEND IN DISTRICT V IN WHICH THE HOME LEAGUE IS HOSTING A TOURNAMENT. Remember to give the coaches the request to host a jamboree. All jamboree requests go to Ken Stelling at 6 Barona Court, Santa Rosa, CA 95405. District V jamborees are listed on the District V website <cysadistrictv.com>

OPEN BOUNDARIES: Open boundaries for league-to-league was approved for **U15's and older**, all other players are still required to have an Inter-League release. All players moving from district to district MUST still have an Inter-District Release form completed by both leagues and District Commissioners.

OUT OF STATE SINGLE EVENT GUEST PLAYER forms must be to me 7 days before the date the team leaves. Coaches may not take more than (18) eighteen players on their travel roster at any time. Teams

may use up to six guest players providing the out of state tournament allows that many guest players. Guest players must use the same years player pass as the team that they will be traveling with. Players from other districts may be used as guest players with the permission of the coaches, leagues and District Commissioners. DO NOT ASK FOR GUEST PLAYER OUT OF DISTRICT VII.

OUT OF STATE TRAVEL: PLEASE IN FORM YOUR COACHES OF THIS POLICY. When traveling out of state, this includes Southern California; the team must have travel papers signed by the league, Ken Stelling, CYSA office and me. ALL PLAYERS ARE REQUIRED TO SIGN THE BLUE TRAVEL ROSTER IN DISTRICT V. PAPERS WILL BE RETURNED IF THEY ARE NOT COMPLETED CORRECTLY. Travel papers must be submitted to 50 days in advance of your travel date. PLEASE SEND A COPY OF THE TEAM ROSTER INCLUDING ALL ADDS, RELEASES, AND TRANSFERS. Please remember to enclose the necessary envelopes, correctly addressed and postage with a check made out to CYSA for \$10.00. All requests to travel out of state for tournament must go to Ken Stelling before they come to me. Follow the instructions on the back of the form.

REFEREES: Referee course are now available. If your league would like to set up a class please send Dave the two different dates that you would like to have a class along with a check for \$270.00 made out to CNRA for each class you would like. If you do not send dates, the time and the place for the class you will not receive the class until you do. **A league official MUST be at every class to supervise the youth that are attending the class. They must have a league check on the last day or night of the class to give to the instructor. The check is to be payable to CYSA District V, \$40.00 each of those who pass the course and \$10.00 for those who do not pass the tester take the information and do not complete the class.** Check out the web.metro.net/cysad5 page for dates, time and place of courses offer.
