DISTRICT MEETING: The next District V meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, November 19, 2002, at 7:30 PM at San Marin High School Library in Novato. Direction off 101 hwy. Take the San Marin exit, go west approximately 5 miles to South Novato Blvd. The school is on the right turn into the parking lot. The meeting room is in the Library Building C.

If you have any questions you may contact either Cheri or myself. Once Cheri has the results for each division coaches will be notify and trophies will be available in about two weeks.

COACHING: Any time is a good time to host a coaching clinic, please contact Ray Erlach, 27 Carnoustie Drive, Novato, CA 94949 (415-788-3322), if your league wants to hold a clinic. Ray will also be getting the orientation course for beginning coaches off the ground this year. If your league is interested in holding an orientation please contact Ray.

ELECTION OF DISTRICT COMMISSIONER FOR DISTRICT V: Since we did not have eight leagues at the district meeting in October, election for the position of District Commissioner was not held. The election will be this month with eight leagues present to vote. I have heard from 4 leagues that are planning to attend. Let me hear from the rest of you, please.

INTER-DISTRICT RELEASE: For incoming inter-district releases I want to remind you that there is a \$5.00 transfer fee payable to CYSA District V. This is for incoming players only. **When you mail me the inter-district release please remember to include the \$5.00 fee.**

JAMBOREES: PLEASE REMEMBER TO REMIND YOUR COACHES THAT THEY MUST HAVE THEIR LEAGUES AND THE DISTRICTS APPROVE **TO HOST OR ATTEND** A JAMBOREE. JAMBOREES MAY NOT BE HOSTED ON A CYSA TOURNAMENT WEEKEND IN DISTRICT V IN WHICH THE HOME LEAGUE IS HOSTING A TOURNAMENT. Remember to give the coaches the request to host a jamboree it can also be found on the District V web site. All jamboree requests go to Ken Stelling at 6 Barona Court, Santa Rosa, CA 95405. District V jamborees are listed on the District V website (www.cysadistrictv.com).

OPEN BOUNDARIES: Open boundaries for league-to-league was approved for U15's and older, all other players are still required to have an Inter-League release. All players moving from district to district MUST have an Inter-District Release form completed by both leagues and both District Commissioners.

OUT OF THE DISTRICT FRIENDLY GAMES: Please remind your coach that if they are going out of the district to play friendly games that they must notify you and the you must notify me.

OUT OF STATE SINGLE EVENT GUEST PLAYER forms must be to me **14 days** before the date the team leaves. **If the coach has them all filled out and signed, they may send them with the travel papers.**

Coaches may not take more than (18) eighteen players on their travel roster at any time. Teams may use up to six guest players providing the out of state tournament allows that many guest players. Guest players must use the same year's player pass as the team that they will be traveling with. Players from other districts may be used as guest players with the permission of the coaches, leagues and District Commissioners. **DO NOT ASK FOR GUEST PLAYERS OUT OF DISTRICT VII. Players from other state organization may not be guest players on CYSA-North teams (i.e., no players, from CYSA-South, Oregon, Washington, etc.).**

OUT OF STATE TRAVEL: PLEASE INFORM YOUR COACHES OF THIS POLICY. When traveling out of state (this includes Southern California); the team must have travel papers signed by the league, Ken Stelling, CYSA office and me. Travel papers must be submitted 50 days in advance of your travel date. **PLEASE SEND A COPY OF THE TEAM ROSTER INCLUDING ALL ADDS, RELEASES, AND TRANSFERS.** Please remember to enclose the necessary envelopes, correctly addressed and postage with a check made out to CYSA for \$10.00. All requests to travel out of state for tournament must go to Ken Stelling before they come to me. Follow the instructions on the back of the form. **LATE FEES: \$25.00, if less than 30 days but more than 14 days prior to the tournament, \$50.00, if less than 14 days but more than 5 days prior to the tournament, \$100.00, if 5 days or fewer prior to the tournament, payable to CYSA District V. Some teams are forgetting to send a copy of their roster, adds and transfers, league registrar's please remember that these need to be included with the request to travel.**

REFEREES: Referee course are now available. Contact Dave Durbin, 1924 Indian Valley Road, Novato, CA. 94947, or phone him at 415-897-8795. Referee courses will be listed on the District V website when the Webmaster receives them.

REGISTRATION: The announced Tide Cup starting date is December 14th. All rosters are frozen on December 1st. To be processed in time, all paperwork must be to Steve by Nov. 29th.

TIDE CUP: Tide Cup will be held on December 14th and 15th, January 11th semi's, with the finals on the 12th.
