**COACHING:** I want to welcome Ray Erlach on to the district staff as the Coach Coordinator, listed below is where Ray can be reached. Ray comes to us from Marin County. Remember coaching courses can be given anytime of the year. Leagues can set up your coaches clinics now, by having your league coaching director set the desired date, alternate date, a check for \$500.00 for the F course, \$600.00 for the E course, \$400.00 for the goalkeepers course or \$1500.00 for the E/D course made payable to CYSA and mail the request to Ray Erlach 27 Carnoustie Drive, Novato, CA 94949 (415-788-3322).

**GUEST PLAYER SINGLE EVENTS FORMS:** ONLY U14 may be a guest player during this time of the year. All CYSA tournament single event forms are to be sent to Steve Pinner for approval, at least 10 days before the tournament.

**JAMBOREES:** PLEASE REMEMBER TO REMIND YOUR COACHES THAT THEY MUST HAVE THEIR LEAGUES AND THE DISTRICTS APPROVE TO HOST OR ATTEND A JAMBOREE. JAMBOREES MAY NOT BE HOSTED ON A CYSA TOURNAMENT WEEKEND IN DISTRICT V IN WHICH THE HOME LEAGUE IS HOSTING A TOURNAMENT. Remember to give the coaches the request to host a jamboree. **OPEN BOUNDARIES:** Open boundaries for league-to-league was approved for U16's and older, all other players are still required to have an Inter-League release. All players moving from district to district MUST still have an Inter-District Release form completed by both leagues and District Commissioners. **At this year's AGM a rule change will be voted on as to allow U15 and older to have open boundaries.**

**OUT OF STATE SINGLE EVENT GUEST PLAYER:** Forms must be to me 7 days before the date the team leaves. Coaches may not take more than (18) eighteen players on their travel roster at any time. Teams may use up to six guest players providing the out of state tournament allows that many guest players. Guest players must use the same years player pass as the team that they will be traveling with. Players from other districts may be used as guest players with the permission of the coaches, leagues and District Commissioners. **DO NOT ASK FOR GUEST PLAYER OUT OF DISTRICT VII.**

**OUT OF STATE TRAVEL: PLEASE INFORM YOUR COACHES OF THIS POLICY.** When traveling out of state, this includes Southern California; the team must have travel papers signed by the league, Ken Stelling, CYSA office and me. **ALL PLAYERS ARE REQUIRED TO SIGN THE BLUE TRAVEL ROSTER IN DISTRICT V. PAPERS WILL BE RETURNED IF THEY ARE NOT COMPLETED CORRECTLY.** Travel papers must be submitted to 50 days in advance of your travel date. **PLEASE SEND A COPY OF THE TEAM ROSTER INCLUDING ALL ADDS, RELEASES, AND TRANSFERS.** Please remember to enclose the necessary envelopes, correctly addressed and postage with a check made out to CYSA for \$10.00. All requests to travel out of state for tournament must go to Ken Stelling before they come to me. Follow the instructions on the back of the form.

**REFEREES:** Referee course are now available. If your league would like to set up a class please send Dave the two different dates that you would like to have a class along with a check for \$270.00 made out to CNRA for each class you would like. If you do not send dates, the time and the place for the class you will not receive the class until you do. Referee courses will be listed on the District V web site when the Webmaster receives them.

**REGISTRATION:** Steve is back home and doing well on his way to recovery. Remember, Steve will not do over night paperwork. **REMEMBER THAT LACK OF PREPLANNING ON YOUR PART DOES NOT CONSTITUTE AN EMERGENCY ON THE DISTRICT REGISTRARS PART.**

**STATE CUP:** State Cup begins this weekend January 19th and 20th at several different sites. Please remind your coaches to check the hotline of the district that they are playing in for updates as to weather, etc. Larry Foehl will be with us for the rest of the season and then will be retiring. I am sure that all of us will miss Larry, but lets welcome Matt Rivera on board. Matt will be working with Larry this season.

**Y-LEAGUE:** There is a league call the Super Y-League it is not affiliate with CYSA. I know that there are coaches in the district that have put teams together to play in the Y-League, I want to remind all leagues in District V that these are **not CYSA teams and are not insured** under

CYSA insurance policies and may not use our certificates of insurance for playing on fields that our league controls. Please check with the holders of our insurance certificates that they are not allowing these teams to play on their fields under CYSA insurance. The teams that play in the Y-League must acquire their own insurance and not use CYSA's certificates of insurance. Parents must be told that these are not CYSA teams and that CYSA insurance is not in effect when the children play on these teams, travel etc.

**Y-LEAGUE REFEREES:** The referee association is a separate from CYSA but is very much part of CYSA. If referees referee in the Y-League their only insurance coverage is through USSF and not CYSA. Referees may referee for any USSF affiliated league.

**YOUTH REFEREE OF THE YEAR:** District V Referee Administer has selected the youth referees of the year from the Windsor Youth Soccer League. The girl's youth referee is Erika Blodow and the boy's is Ryan Baker. Congratulations to both. We thank all leagues that sent in the names of their youth referees for consideration.
