GUEST PLAYERS: All requests for guest players for CYSA in state tournaments must go to Steve Pinner for signatures. The request must be to Steve 14 days before the tournament. **ALL OUT OF STATE GUEST PLAYERS MUST FOLLOW THE GUEST PLAYER POLICY SHOWN ON THE FORM ON PAGE 70 OF THE CYSA TEAM MANUAL. GUEST PLAYERS MAY NOT BE USED FOR LEAGUE GAMES.**

JAMBOREES: Leagues are not getting the message out to their coaches about filling out the form for Jamborees and to have them approved by their league and the district. The form may be found on the District V webpage (www.cysadistrictv.com). **THE LEAGUE AND DISTRICT MUST APPROVE HOSTING OR ATTENDING A JAMBOREE. JAMBOREES MAY NOT BE HOSTED ON A CYSA TOURNAMENT WEEKEND IN DISTRICT V IN WHICH THE HOME LEAGUE IS HOSTING A TOURNAMENT. Remember to give the coaches the request to host a jamboree. ALL PLAYERS NEED PLAYER PASSES TO ATTEND JAMBOREES, EVEN U-10's**

LEAGUE UPDATES: If your league has new board members, please fill out a league update form and send it to the CYSA Office at 1040 Serpentine Lane, Suite 201, Pleasanton, CA 94566. PLEASE take care of this so that your new league officers are put on the mailing list for the district and the state. The form may be found on the CYSA website (www.cysanorth.org).

OUT OF THE DISTRICT FRIENDLY GAMES: Please remind your coaches that if they are going out of the district to play friendly games that they must notify you and then you must notify Jan Bull. Remember Nor-Cal and US Club are not part of CYSA.

OPEN BOUNDARIES: Open boundaries for league-to-league was approved for all players. All players transferring from district to district after they have been assigned to a team in District V MUST have transfer papers completed by both coaches, leagues and District Commissioners/Registrars.

OUT OF STATE TRAVEL: NO U10 TEAM MAY TRAVEL OUTSIDE OF CYSA NORTH FOR THE PURPOSE OF ATTENDING A TOURNAMENT OR JAMBOREES (voted on at the CYSA Board of Directors meeting July 16, 2000). When traveling out of state (this includes Southern California), the team must have travel papers signed by the league, Ken Stelling, CYSA office and Jan Bull. Travel papers must be submitted 45 days in advance of your travel date. PLEASE SEND A COPY OF THE TEAM ROSTER INCLUDING ALL ADDS, RELEASES, AND TRANSFERS. Please remember to enclose the necessary envelopes, correctly addressed with postage, along with a check made out to CYSA for \$10.00. All requests to travel out of state for tournament must go to Ken Stelling before they come to Jan Bull. Follow the instructions on the back of the form. **LATE FEES: \$25.00 if less than 30 days but more than 14 days prior to the tournament, \$50.00 if less than 14 days but more than 5 days prior to the tournament, \$100.00 if 5 days or fewer prior to the tournament, payable to CYSA District V.**

OUT REACH FUNDS: Leagues may apply to the district for CYSA Out Reach Funds for the 2004-05 Season. Please send a list of the players that your league is sponsoring, the amount of the league registration fees, if the player has paid any of the fee, and how much the league is sponsoring each player for. Then the district will have CYSA cut a check for the league for a portion of the request or the entire request. Remember there are 21 leagues in the district and we will do our best to help leagues out. Out Reach Fund can also help with replacement of goals, if that is where the leagues need the help.

PIM 04-1 (effective September 12, 2004): All players, parents, coaches, and referees are required to act as a reasonable person concerning player safety, including protecting players from wearing any equipment or device that is dangerous to the player wearing the equipment or device or to any other player. Dangerous equipment and devices include but are not limited to orthopedic casts, air-splints or metal splints. Players wearing any dangerous equipment or device, including orthopedic casts, air-splints or metal splints, shall not be eligible to participate in any game, practice, tryout or training session.

REFEREES: Referee courses are available. If your league would like to set up a class please send Dave Durbin the two different dates that you would like to have a class, along with a check for \$270.00 made out to CNRA for each class you would like. If you do not send dates, the time and the place for the class you will not receive the class until you do so. A league official MUST be at every class to supervise the youth that are attending the class. They must have a league check on the last day or night of the class to give to the instructor. The check is to be payable to CYSA District V, \$40.00 each of those who pass the course and \$10.00 for those who do not pass the test (or take the information and do not complete the class). REGISTRATION: Rosters were due to Steve October 1, 2004. I hope all registrars have them turned in by now. If not, do it NOW, please.

REGISTRATION: There is a least a two-week turn around on rosters and passes that are sent to Steve for processing. You must also leave yourself enough time to laminate the passes when they are returned to you. **REMEMBER THAT LACK OF PREPLANNING ON YOUR PART DOES NOT CONSTITUTE AN EMERGENCY ON THE DISTRICT REGISTRAR'S PART.** Remember to submit updates of your registration is to Steve by the first of every month.

RED CARDS, SENDOFFS OR EJECTIONS: Please remind your league referees that the sendoff/ejection reports from the District V Playing League are to be sent to Michael Mullins, P.O. Box 184, Kenwood, CA 95452.

SENOFFS AND RED CARDS: REMEMBER IT IS THE COACH THAT SETS THE TONE ON THE GAME. IF THE COACH IS UNDER CONTROL, AND EXPECTS THE PARENTS ON THE TEAM TO CONTROL THEMSELVES WE WILL NOT HAVE THE NUMBER OF SENDOFFS AS WE HAVE HAD IN THE PAST. Players control themselves on the field if the coaches control themselves on the sidelines. **REMEMBER THAT THE SUSPENSION FOR A PLAYER IS AT LEAST ONE GAME, COACHES WILL RECEIVE WHAT THE PLAYER WOULD RECEIVE PLUS TWO EXTRA GAMES (PER 4:08:06).**

STATE CUP: U14 through U19 teams may have up to five transfers onto their team. They must designate the transfers onto the team with the first, second and third player. The four and fifth players transferred onto the team may **ONLY** play in State Cup and may attend no other events with the team. Please be sure to designate the players because if five transfers arrive to be processed, Steve will just process them one through five and the team might end up with players being first, second or third choice, when the coach actually wants them only as the State Cup players.

TOURNAMENTS: Requests for hosting a tournament for the 2005-06 season are due to Ken by November 20th. You may also deliver them to Ken at the district meeting. All sendoffs from tournament are sent to Jan Bull. Jan will then send them on to the league.
