Minutes: Minutes from District Meeting held May 15<sup>th</sup> meeting, motion to approve made by Paula Rudd, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Barry Commerford. Approved with no corrections.

Treasurer's Report: May Financials completed, June deposits in. One or two outstanding expenses for last year. All referees need to get in their info.

Registrar's Report: As of 7-1-07 16,526 players were registered.

I have received 227 teams for processing. Of those 185 are complete with 42 go. I am currently working on Rosters for the August 11 tournament date. I have not received rosters from Mill Valley and Napa; I am concerned that if these come in at the last minute, they will not be completed before my vacation starting August 24<sup>th</sup>. Compared to last year I am looking for another 120 rosters to show up!

The registration committee had an informal meeting last weekend, overall the new program is working well with a few bugs that are being addressed, and input for changes being handled as they come in. The registration form we currently use (1601 form) is being redesigned to match the League One format. This will make inputting of data much easier as the form and program format will be the same.

Association Cup: No Report.

Coaching: OPEN. We really need to get someone in this position. It is mostly scheduling of courses. The District did not have an E/D course this year. Clearlake and Windsor still waiting to get a coaching course scheduled.

Founders' Cup: No Report.

ODP: In the middle of ODP. We have had tryouts and the teams are up and running!! There are some kids at regional came now and are really excited!

PAD: 25 red cards down from 40 last year, 2 coaches down from 6 last year, "mouth" problems. 1 protest last year, denied. Came in 9/11/06 and was decided by 9/27/06. Main problem with getting decision back on red card is that the report is not in within 24 hours like it is supposed to be. Recreation: Not received anything from Corey in a while. Has done some Pre F courses. Rincon Valley doing Pre F next week.

Rules & Revisions: No Report.

Referee Administrator: Informal guidance assessments, Spencer and Cole are both available any weekend to come out and be there to assess referees. On adult side, if you have adult refs that would like to upgrade, we are more than happy to come out and assess.

Referee Director of Instruction: No Report. Though, Michael is making a big effort getting instructors for the last few classes. Please have leagues schedule their ref classes before the summer months and instructors will be more likely available.

State Cup: Santa Rosa U16 girls went to Regionals, tough draw where they had semi finalist, qtr finalists, win, tie and loss. Extremely hot in Las Vegas. 7pm and 2 9pm games and they did not have to play on turf. U12 Boys team from Mill Valley went and represented District V very well.

TOPS: Just finished up. 33 kids registered, 2 dropped, the parents thought there would be older kids playing. One individuals needs were very pronounced, which was ok because we do not think we would have been able to help. 8 week session. We would like to offer again in October and take it inside. They are working with Sports City to try and get the indoor field donated. The kids all had a blast. Ages range from 4 year olds to 15 year olds. We had about a 2 to 1 ratio, we would start in small groups and do warm-ups and then do some small scrimmages. Paula is very interested in growing this program within the District and would like to go to the league board meetings.

Tournaments: 1<sup>st</sup> tournament will be in about 3 weeks. Applications 10% down from last year. Most of DI are U11 and U12. There are a lot tournaments on the calendar still.

Division I Fall League: Vicki is busy working on scheduling.

Division I Winter: No Report.

Division III Fall: Cheri has put out the draft schedules online.

Division III Winter: Checks due for league play no later than 7/21. Whitney will start scheduling when all checks and forms are in.

Unfinished Business: D&O Insurance form... a letter was sent out by John Murphy that D&O will end in August. Central Marin, Healdsburg, Humboldt, Rohnert Park & WESCO are the only leagues with Bollinger Insurance. Liability Insurance also needs to be renewed for the 2007-2008 playing year.
