**MINUTES:** No quorum, March minutes not approved.

**TREASURER:** Jan distributed financial report for period through April 11.

**REGISTRAR:** District computer being replaced, CReg files updated. May 3 is State registrars meeting.

**ASSOCIATION CUP:** Excused. The tournament is finished. Standings are on the state website. Kathy Dunnagan has had a request for Coed teams to play and is investigating the possibilities for next year.

**COACHING:** District sponsored E/D will be in Rohnert Park. Class is full, with 15 signed up. Ahmed Ibrihim is teaching the course. Courses are not starting as early as we had hoped for. Leagues are waiting for registration rather than setting up courses in advance.

**ODP:** Excused. Flyer was distributed and is also posted on the district website ([www.cysadistrictv.com](http://www.cysadistrictv.com)). Tryouts are a MAGNOLIA PARK in Rohnert Park, rain or shine. This year players are being asked to bring \$10 in cash (training fee) plus \$50 check inside a self-addressed envelope.

**PAD:** Excused.

**RECREATION:** Bruce distributed applications for Orientation Forms, which is similar to F Course. Mail to Bruce at 4407 Hampton Ct. Rohnert Park, CA 94928. Form can be faxed to 707-584-9116. Bruce will attend Tide Cup meeting in May.

**RULES & REVISIONS:** No report.

**STATE CUP:** Excused. Tournament is doing well - Santa Rosa still has 3 teams competing, Sonoma County Alliance and Marin United each have one team still in.

**TOURNAMENTS:** The new user-friendly 2003/2004 Tournament Calendar is now on the CYSA website ([www.cysanorth.org](http://www.cysanorth.org)). Go to Programs, Tournaments. New user-friendly application form is also on the website. Old form OK till July 31 tournaments. August, Sept, etc. tournaments require new form. Ken won't send forms to CYSA till May 1. Mandatory Tournament Coordinators Meeting April 26/27 at the Fremont Merriott. Lots of vendors with goodies to distribute. Reminder about District EVENTS (only District V Teams): Get approval from Jan/Ken PRIOR to advertising the event. Events are not jamborees or CYSA tournaments. See page 63 of the CYSA Team Manual for a description of "event". Ken reported that the upcoming Hawaii tournament is not a USYS-sanctioned event. Teams that are planning to go must understand that they are not covered by CYSA insurance.

**DISTRICT V PLAYING LEAGUE:**

**CLASS I:** Marja reported that winter league was completed, with 5 divisions playing. Only one division had problems: Four girls teams were unable to play as scheduled due to a conflict with high school soccer. All Class I forms are posted on the District website ([www.cysadistrictv.com](http://www.cysadistrictv.com)), and have been emailed to the league presidents, Class I coordinators, and last year's teams. Forms due to Marja June 1, with \$50 per team. Mandatory coaches meeting at Lucchesi Community Center (see website for details). Hopefully younger teams will have schedules by August 1. Older teams will meet again in September to finalize schedules.

**CLASS III:** Cheri reported that forms were all sent to league presidents and known Class III Coordinators. Several leagues have not acknowledged receipt, and the forms will be snail-mailed to those leagues. Forms are also posted on the website ([www.cysadistrictv.com](http://www.cysadistrictv.com)). Due date of May 1 is flexible, due to many leagues not being done with tryouts at that time.

Gary Kuhn submitted a draft format for the U16 and U19 Boys to Jan for approval. Jan recommended a meeting with the teams to formalize the schedules.

**CLASS IV:** Jan reported that Dixie and WESCO are interested in putting U19 Girls Class IV teams together.

**UNFINISHED BUSINESS:** None.

**NEW BUSINESS:** Jan thanked Cheri for getting the district website up-to-date.

**DISTRICT COMMISSIONER REPORT:** Jan reminded Steve Pinner to get registration due dates to Cheri for website publishing. Jan reminded leagues to fill out requests for insurance certificates (forms available on CYSA website: [www.cysanorth.org](http://www.cysanorth.org)). All leagues have completed League Affiliation paperwork. We are the only district with all league affiliation forms turned in. Head gear is not required. New PIM regarding shin guards states that shin guards are still required, and must be sized appropriately for the age of the player.

**GOOD OF THE GAME:** Bruce reported that the tape received from CYSA was great. Jan said the state office will supply more copies for \$2.75 each. Tracie reported that the U19 Boys Wolves won A-Cup and is seeking sponsors to help them get to Hawaii. Cheri reported that U16 Boys Santa Rosa Laguna Pumas won A-Cup. Jan reported that Bend it Like Beckham is an excellent movie about a girl from India, who is struggling to overcome cultural obstacles in order to play soccer.
