MINUTES: May 2005 minutes approved as modified Wesco/Central Marin

TREASURER: Absent

REGISTRAR: Current forms and effective dates need attention most errors are with the guest player and coaches' forms. 350 teams so far. Pre-session sheets are given priority to, but tournament dates are being noted, but not first game dates. Once a month Win Reg exports are to be given to Steve and not all Leagues are in compliance. ASSOCIATION CUP: Excused - No Report

COACHING: Excused – No Report

ODP: Open Pool ready to close. Closing to 20 players. Humboldt and Clearlake had a better showing this year. Division 3 players are experiencing a higher level of play. 30 Clinics for Preventive injuries (90 Minutes long) had a positive feedback. September and October ODP will be dormant until start of State Cup. \$10.00 to tryout and \$50.00 to cover the cost of trainings. Additional costs are travel to trainings and play dates. During tryouts players are broken down in 3 groups. 1989 U17 only 1 tryout. Highest level invited to return in March, lower level players that don't meet the standards are excused and for the in between players they are invited back another day for further evaluations.

Some are calling it a new rule where others are stating that is better described. Player that is in the offside position, but not in the play should not be consider to the offence of offsides.

DISTRICT V PLAYING LEAGUE:

DIVISION I FALL: Schedule submitted in July and only five Leagues returned on time. Turn around time needs to be quicker.

DIVISION 1 WINTER: No Report

DIVISION III FALL: Cheri reported via e-mail that she had several teams drop out at the last minute and one team being added on August 5th. All games are now posted on the website. A copy of the game schedule, District playing league rules and CYSA team Manuel had all been given out to the Division 3 Coordinators. She thanks all for job well done.

DIVISION III WINTER: Summer portion of season is over. Winter portion of session is now in a draft stage. Expectations of 30 plus teams (boys and girls) will be playing during this Alternative Season, up from 7 boy teams in 2003. There are 7 girl teams that will have a total of 54 games. The girls requested more games and longer halves, which made cost much higher than the boys. \$935.00 plus \$75.00 per team to guarantee their spot. The boys are only paying \$450.00 plus \$75.00.

DIVISION IV: Schedules are out; waiting on all to return to complete and finalize games. U16 and U19 must wear matching uniforms. Each League/Club should be providing a numbered Jersey and each teams socks and shorts should be at least same color. This is a reflection on our Clubs, Leagues and District. Its is also helpful for the referees when the players are in proper attire.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS:

NEW BUSINESS: Vicki Sodaro will be investigating a referee assignors program for our District Playing League games.

DISTRICT COMMISSIONER REPORT: You can download League change notices from the CYSA North Website. All Coaches forms 1628 stay in League for 5 years unless being followed up on a past incident by CYSA. All Leagues need to write letters on where they are on incorporated status by August 30, 2005. Disadvantages are you lose your protection for board members for lawsuits. CYSA Board looking to drop out with their affiliation with USSF. They are not youth-orientated and we pay \$1.00 a player. The only advantage with this affiliation is the players get half off (50%) of inter-National entry fee. The affiliation with USYS allows us to play in Regional and National Play. They also offer coaches courses and workshops. There cost is .50 cents a player.

GOOD OF THE GAME: Rohnert Parks U16G team ventured off to Norway. 128 teams attended and they became 2nd in their flight and lost in next level... Great experience...
