MINUTES: August, September, October, 2005 minutes approved as modified (Rohnert park/Central Marin)

TREASURER: Report distributed. Fiscal year ended 8/31/05, and all sent to CYSA by 10/1/05, no questions so far.

REGISTRAR: 27,511 players registered to date but Central Marin looks low, down about 2,000 players vs. last year. Processed 501 teams. Roster freeze dates for Cups are on website. A new combination form for Adds, Releases, Transfers has been released by CYSA. WinReg upgrades were sent to registrars and are due by 1/1/06. 5 transfers are being allowed for State Cup play.

AMERICAN CUP: U12 will play at Ripping and U14 will be at Morgan Hill. From District 5 there were the following teams:
