MINUTES: November 2005, minutes approved (C. Marin/R Park).

TREASURER: Report distributed. There is a new Sub-account: Div III Winter League-Girls. Records were received back from CYSA Audit. Passed and all is okay.

REGISTRAR: 28,430 registered players for 2005-6. There will be new forms: Adds, Transfers, Releases for players and adults will be all on one form. The guest player form has been changed and will be available on the CYSA web site. As the AGM is in March, the district 5 registrar's meeting will be the end of March or first of April. All league supplies have been ordered and should be coming soon.

AMERICAN CUP: Note: Luigi did Ripon all by himself. Referees are needed for the weekend of Feb. 25/26 Quarter finals. D5 Teams: U12B - 2 teams, U14B - 2 teams. Olders who will play: U16G - 4, U19G - 6, U16B - 3, U19B - 2.

ASSOCIATION CUP:

Teams advancing from D5 to the round of 16: U12G - 2, U12B - 1, U13G - 1, U14G - 3, U14B - 3.

COACHING: Two page report submitted. Fees for coaching classes go up this year. Cloverdale will be able to use the 2005 fees paid for a class in 2006. There has been a request to do away with the one year waiting period between each class taken (so you could take the F and then the E in the same year). We have two nominations for coach of the year in D5: Mark Dunn SRYSL, Steve Seneka SRYSL. Novato did two weekends of 'train the trainers' events, teaching div. 1 and 3 coaches to be trainers for div 4 coaches. Ask Ray if you have interest in providing this to your league.

RECREATION: Bruce would like leagues to review and give feedback on two programs: 1) A contract for parents to sign about appropriate behavior. 2) A parent guide with an overview of CYSA explaining what we do, similar to the old 3 fold one.
