Minutes: Minutes from District Meeting held February 20th, 2007; motion to approve made by Art Feagles/WESCO and was 2nd by Steve Senecka/Santa Rosa. Minutes were approved with no corrections.

Treasurer's Report: January and February financials handed out. There were 2 large amounts for Referee's which bills were just received to pay the refs for Division I & III playing leagues that just ended. Still working on changing the names of the accounts.

Registrar's Report: As of 3/30/2007, registration count is 27,737. This is down 1,300 from 2006. Registration for Spring league and U19 players are still coming in. Steve will be attending a training workshop on 3/31. April 22nd will be our district's registration training workshops. One session will be held in the morning and one in the afternoon. The training will be held at Slater Middle School, 3500 Sonoma

Avenue. There will also be a training workshop for our north leagues in Crescent City. After all of the training is completed, the new registration program will go into affect. Form 1601 will still be used. Form 1606 will not be needed for adds, however it will still be needed for transfers. Form 1628 will be used this year. New players will have a unique ID number, (3 initials, CYSA generated number and mother's month and day of birth (not year!))

TOPS: Paula Rudd is running a TOPS program, (a program designed to allow children with special needs the chance to play soccer), for our district out of Windsor. Currently there are 15 players. This program is done at no charge. There is a flyer that will be sent out from the schools promoting the program and hopefully the Press Democrat will run an ad as well. The "bells and whistles" are what are most important to the kids (ie: uniforms, pictures, trophies, etc.) Paula is a parent of a special needs child and hopes to grow the TOPS program. Please keep on the look out for emails regarding coaches training if you are interested in volunteering in the program.

Association Cup: Semis and Finals are to be held in Redding March 24th. We have some District V teams playing, Marin 16 Boys will be playing at 9 am, Santa Rosa Laguna 19 Boys at 3 pm and Sonoma 16 Girls at 11 am).

Coaching: OPEN. Ray will still be assisting us with the classes until a replacement is found. Novato is hosting the E/D Course.

Founders' Cup: Founder's Cup is over. A lot of red cards, 3 were at the start of the games, though none in District V. No girls teams advanced. U16 Boys Sonoma Falcons made it to quarter finals but lost to Sac. 2 U19 Girls teams played, 1 Petaluma team won. Three coaches were sent off the field, one team had to forfeit a game.

ODP: Tryouts are schedule for May 6th, 12th and 13th and will be held in Petaluma and Novato. ODP coaches training will be May 5th. There will possibly be tryouts in April held in Ukiah. More info to come. ODP camps are dependent of field availability, possible dates are May 21st in Ukiah and early June in Santa Rosa, Novato or Marin. The turnout was great for District V ODP pools. Info to be posted on the website.
