Minutes: Minutes from District Meeting held October 16th, 2007, not approved– NOT ENOUGH LEAGUES TO VOTE!

Treasurer's Report: No Report.

Registrar's Report: Last year there were 27,996 kids registered (May 23). As of October this year, there are 27,324. Konocti YSL only have 161 players where as last year they had over 400. Cups are coming up, Founders cup last day for changes (youngers) 2 weeks prior to the announced starting date. Olders are coming up. A lot of forms are coming that are outdated. Please look at the CYSA website for the most current forms. 1628 forms are coming in that are 3 years old. Steve is getting a lot of flack from the office with not having the correct, most updated form. Here are some examples of leagues missing information because of the wrong forms being used - Cloverdale (65% of info missing), 1% of Santa Rosa info missing. At the last board meeting, they okayed the U17-U19 olders rosters. They can put 22 on the roster but are ONLY good for State Cup. 4th & 5th transfer, U14-19 ok for State Cup only. Sticker or stamp is going to be put on the player pass for the 4-5 players that are JUST THERE for State Cup only. For check in, player pass, golden rod and 1601 only.

Association Cup: 600 teams entered and there were some venue changes - U12 Girls Morgan Hill, U12 Boys Fremont, U13 Boys and Girls Cherry Island, U14 Boys Turlock, U14 Girls Morgan Hill and Redding, U16 Girls Morgan Hill, U16 Boys Cherry Island, U19 Girls Redding, U19 Girls Ripon or Fresno. Please watch website. Rounds of 16 and Quarters will be in Ripon and Semi-Finals in at Mustang in Danville.

Coaching: Received two nominations for Coach of the Year on girls side, Central Marin & Eureka. Has not received the nomination from the boys side yet, but has heard there is one. The Commissioner is holding open (even though we are not supposed to) we would like to get at least 2 from the boys side. Dan and Bruce will go over the apps and select then submit them to Ray Erlach. We are trying to get Carl come over to District V for the new coaches to come and listen to him around March or April.

Committee made the change and now there are more teams participating because of the change, playing in venues from Fresno to Redding. All leagues are playing everywhere. Coaches just need to check the state website for venue. Finals for youngsters will be in District V, the venue will be in Santa Rosa at Trione fields. All details being worked out. Olders will be at the new Morgan Hill complex. At the AGM we will voting on the olders venues. District V wants Santa Rosa to put in for olders finals for 2009.
