Minutes: Minutes from the March and April District meetings...Motion to approve without corrections made by, Jackie Zlokovich and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Barry Commerford. Both months approved with no corrections.

Treasurer: Nothing to report tonight. Still missing March's statement. Ron will email the report to everyone once it is complete.

Registrar: As of today, we have 7,110 registered for this coming season. 20 teams so far on new workflow system. There was a registration committee meeting last Sunday in Sacramento. Number of votes per league will now be based on a new fraction ratio. 1 vote for every 500 players. Number of players will be frozen 60 days before AGM. Also, notices will be sent to all people who have access to League One that will need to be completed and sent back into the State office by June 15<sup>th</sup>. If the notice isn't back by the 15<sup>th</sup> then those individuals will have their access taken away. A 1628 form will be required for all those that have access to League One. A new manual will also be coming out.

Commissioner's Report: Steve Larsen did send games cards of teams with no shows and forfeits. League Presidents, if you are disputing invoices that were sent out, we need to meet on an individual basis to iron out the fines. If these fines are not paid, then the teams/leagues will not be able to play this season. All games have to go through a coordinator. It is not an official game if the game was paid cash.

Donations being requested from leagues with used soccer equipment. A friend of the commissioners will be collecting all the equipment and will be shipping to Kenya, Nairobi to allow that kids to play soccer.

Association Cup: Venues are available on the website. At Morgan Hill - Girls u19 had 29 red cards.

Coaching: Received 20 applications for coaching courses. 1 Pre-F, 13 F Courses, 4 E/D Courses, and 1 Goalkeepers Course (Mad River).

ODP: Tryouts last weekend. Turnouts were really good, Marin, Novato, Napa, Humboldt showed. Disappointed that not many from Santa Rosa showed for tryouts. Hopefully all of the DOCs received a flyer about ODP. We are encouraging Div 3 and Div 1 to come out. Accepting registration to June 1<sup>st</sup>. 1<sup>st</sup> weekend we had 70 total, 2<sup>nd</sup> weekend, totals are being added up but it looks like there was definitely more.

Founder's Cup: Nothing to report.

Recreation: Nothing to report. Meeting with Corey Nelson next month.

Referee Director of Assessment: Sent 4 people to the Assessors Clinic last weekend. There are now 6 Assessors in District 5. All Assessors will need to make a trip up North at least once.

Referee Director of Instruction: Our new DDI is Jim Moraga. Welcome! He will be taking over June 1<sup>st</sup>.

Director of Youth Referee: Still looking to fill this position.

Rules & Revisions: No Report.

State Cup: District 5 had a great showing this year at State Cup. 3 teams made it to Championships – U15 Girls Santa Rosa United Thunder, U18 Girls Santa Rosa United Gold 90 and U16 Boys Santa Rosa United Gold 92. All teams played very well!

Tournaments: Last weekend, Tournament Directors workshop. 3 reps from district 5 were there. As well all know, there are 13 months on the 07-08 and there is a 08-09 calendar. The 07-08 form is to be used ONLY for the 07-08 calendar. The 08-09 form is can ONLY be used for the 08-09 calendar. The Tournament committee is going to go to a “forever form” for the next tournament calendar form. Every person who applies to a tournament has the right to request the rules at ANY TIME. It is suggested that if your team is thinking about going to a tournament, that you receive the rules. They have changed A LOT!

Division I Fall: There will be a very short, Division I U11 playing league to qualify the teams that want to go to State Cup. Teams must play in the playing league in order to be eligible to go to any Cups.

Division III Fall: The Team Registrations and League Entry, plus all fees were due to Cheri by 5/15. Exceptions were made for leagues still holding their tryouts during the month of May. I have received packets from Central Marin, Clearlake, Healdsburg, Konocti, Mad River, Mill Valley, Napa, Rohnert Park, Sonoma, Tiburon, Ukiah, WESCO and West Marin. When I have received Coast, Humboldt, Novato, Petaluma, Santa Rosa and Windsor, I will send out a report letting everyone know how many teams there are in each division.

Please remember that if your league enters two teams in the same age/gender, the teams must be equal in strength to one another (no strong/weak teams).
